



Match-funding fundraising

Many companies throughout the UK offer employees the chance to support fundraising efforts by 'matching' the money they raise. This means that an employee who volunteers at a Friends of Wellington School event can then apply to their employer for match funding. Sometimes organisations will match £ for £ and others will specify what they are prepared to give.

How can you help?

Please ask your employer if they operate or are interested in running a match funding scheme. If they do, they may ask you to complete a request form or put your pledge in writing.
