

Top 5 things to do with your 3- or 4-year-old over the half term holidays...



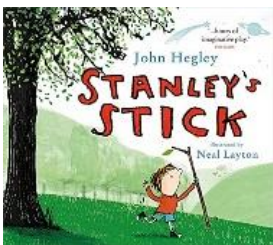
1. Go conker bonkers!

Find conkers; count them, compare sizes, make a necklace, construct a conker run using cardboard tubes, compare the amounts – more than, fewer than.



2. Marvel at beautiful leaves from the trees!

Make a collection of autumn leaves, print with them, thread them and make a leaf mobile, snip them with scissors, sort the colours, run through them, try to catch one as it falls from a tree and listen to the sound as you crunch them in your hand.



3. Make it quick and find a stick!

What can you make from your stick? Use the story book 'Stanley's Stick' or 'Stick Man' for inspiration. Play pooh sticks, make a fishing rod, which numerals or letters can you make? Compare lengths – longer or shorter than mine? Stir a mud pie or write in the sand.



4. Build a den again and again!

Make a den inside or outside using drapes, pegs, furniture, boxes etc.
